Protecting Pain-Capable Unborn Children from Late-Term Abortions Act

The *Protecting Pain-Capable Unborn Children from Late-Term Abortions Act* would protect unborn children by prohibiting abortion at 15 weeks, a point by which the unborn child is capable of experiencing great pain when being killed by dismemberment or other late abortion methods.

Marco Rubio supports the bill to protect unborn babies who can feel pain from late abortions.

Val Demings supports a policy of unlimited abortion, even late in pregnancy when the unborn child can feel pain.

Pro-Abortion Legislation

Pro-abortion groups are advocating for legislation that would enshrine abortion on demand in federal law and policies and strike down existing pro-life laws on the state level.
